HB135 Clouse		General Fund Budget, substitute passed by the House Ways and Means General Fund committee fully funds ERS at the actuarially requested rate.	Vetoed by the Governor; Veto Overridden by House but not Senate.
Johnson (R)		Increases the return to work compensation limits from \$24,000 to \$30,000.	Enacted - Act 2015-410
SB35 Allen		Proposes a Constitutional Amendment to allow Lamar County sheriffs to participate in ERS.	Enacted - Act 2015-26

SB45 Marsh	HB192 Collins	Authorizes the creation of public charter schools. Provides that conversion charter schools must participate in TRS and PEEHIP and start-up charter schools may elect to participate in TRS and PEEHIP.	Enacted - Act 2015-3
SB179 Pittman	HB155 Poole	Education Trust Fund Budget, substitute passed by the Senate sets PEEHIP funding for FY16 at \$780 per active employee per month and fully funds TRS at the actuarially requested rate.	Enacted - Act 2015-281
SB298 Marsh	HB392 McMillan	Allows ERS local units, which did not previously elect to provide the one-time bonus to its retirees as allowed by Act 2014-429, additional time to elect to provide the bonus.	Enacted - Act 2015-444
SB411 Orr		Reforms retirement benefits for judges and justices elected or appointed after November 8, 2016; provides that district attorneys and circuit clerks elected or appointed after November 8, 2016 will participate in retirement under JRF plans upon passage of a constitutional amendment; provides preretirement death benefits for members of JRF.	Enacted - Act 2015-498

SB421 Orr		Proposes a Constitutional Amendment to allow clerks and district attorneys to participate in a state-administered retirement program. Is a companion bill to SB411.	Enacted - Act 2015-342
SB469 Chambliss		Proposes a Constitutional Amendment to allow the Autauga County sheriff to participate in ERS.	Enacted - Act 2015-218
