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ENROLLED, An Act,

Relating to Choctaw County; to allow the Choctaw County Revenue Commissioner to simultaneously receive supernumerary retirement benefits and retirement benefits from the Teachers' Retirement System so long as the retirement benefits are related to different and separate time periods of employment or service; and to provide for a retroactive effective date.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) This act shall apply only to Choctaw County.


(b) So long as the Revenue Commissioner has satisfied all prerequisites to receive supernumerary retirement benefits, payment for supernumerary retirement benefits may not be denied as a result of the Revenue Commissioner also receiving retirement benefits from the Teachers' Retirement System, provided that the retirement benefits are related to different and separate time periods of employment or service.

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law, and shall be retroactive to October 1, 2003.


