1 SB215 2 3 4 ENROLLED, An Act, To provide for a funded one-time lump-sum addition 5 6 to the retirement benefits of certain retirees of the 7 Employees' Retirement System. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA: 8 9 Section 1. (a) There is provided for fiscal year 2017-2018 a funded one-time lump-sum payment, hereinafter 10 referred to as lump-sum payment, to each person except those 11 whose employer participated in the Employees' Retirement 12 System pursuant to Sections 36-27-6, 36-27-7, and 36-27-7.1, 13 Code of Alabama 1975, whose effective date of retirement for 14 purposes of receiving benefits from the Employees' Retirement 15 System is prior to May 1, 2018, and who is receiving or is 16 entitled to receive a monthly allowance from the Employees' 17 Retirement System on April 30, 2018. 18

(b) The formula for calculating the lump-sum payment
shall be one dollar (\$1) per month for each year of service
attained by the retiree.

(c) Beneficiaries of deceased members or deceased
retirees, except where the deceased member or deceased retiree
retired from any employer participating in the Employee's
Retirement System pursuant to Sections 32-27-6, 36-27-7, and

1 36-27-7.1, Code of Alabama 1975, if the date of death for the 2 deceased member, or the effective date of retirement for the 3 deceased retiree for purposes of receiving benefits form the 4 Employees' Retirement System prior to May 1, 2018, and if the 5 beneficiary is receiving or is entitled to receive a monthly 6 allowance from the Employees' Retirement System on April 30, 7 2018, shall receive a lump-sum payment.

8 (d) For purposes of this act, service includes the 9 service under Section 36-27-1 and Section 36-27-170 et seq., 10 Code of Alabama 1975, as well as state police bonus credit or 11 hazardous duty (FLC bonus) credit.

Section 2. Any person who received benefits under 12 the Medicaid program and whose eligibility for Medicaid 13 benefits would be impaired by the lump-sum payment provided by 14 this act shall not be entitled to receive the aforementioned 15 increase. Any person who subsequently applies for benefits 16 17 under the Medicaid program and that person's eligibility to receive benefits is impaired by the lump-sum payment provided 18 by this act shall not be entitled to receive the increase 19 20 subsequent to the date that the member files application for 21 benefits under the Medicaid program.

22 Section 3. The Board of Control of the Employees' 23 Retirement System shall determine the amount required to pay 24 the cost of the lump-sum payments provided under this act and 25 shall notify the chief fiscal officer of each employer of the

increases in the employer rate required to be paid to the system. For the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2019 only, each employer shall pay the increase in the employer rate in the same manner and from the same source of funds as salaries of active members are paid.

Section 4. The lump-sum payments provided under this
act shall be paid to all eligible recipients by the Employees'
Retirement System in June 2018.

9 Section 5. It is the intent of the Legislature that
10 the appropriation in the SB178 for purposes of the bill may be
11 reappropriated for fiscal year 2020.

Section 6. This act shall become effective
immediately following its passage and approval by the
Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
