Week 12 Update

The Legislature convened for the twenty-eighth and twenty-ninth legislative days of the Regular Session this week.

This week, the Governor signed both the General Fund and Education Trust Fund budgets.

The Senate passed HB542, by Rep. Shaver, which allows supernumerary district attorneys to draw both supernumerary benefits and retirement benefits if the benefits are based on different years of service.

The House passed SB244, by Sen. Melson, which creates the crime of theft of employee retirement benefits.

Hb621, by Rep. Colvin, was introduced and would prohibit future employees of the Alabama High School Athletic Association from participating in TRS.
