

### **Week 8 Update**

The Legislature convened for the eighteenth and nineteenth legislative days of the Regular Session this week.

The Senate Finance and Taxation Education committee substituted and approved SB280, by Sen. Waggoner, which would allow vested members of TRS and ERS to purchase service credit for federal nonmilitary service.

The House passed HB312, by Rep. Hill, which would increase the benefit multiplier for members of the District Attorneys' Plan from 3% to 4%.

The Senate substituted and passed HB138, by Rep. Paschal, which allows retirees to work full-time as bus drivers, adds law enforcement officers to the temporary return-to-work exception that allows retirees to earn up to \$52,000, adds service requirements to that exception, and sunsets the bill in 2032.

No new bills dealing with RSA were introduced this week.
