

- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
- 8 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution
- 9 of Alabama of 2022, is proposed and shall become valid as a
- 10 part of the constitution when all requirements of this act are
- 11 fulfilled:
- 12 PROPOSED AMENDMENT
- In Geneva County, mayors of municipalities that
- 14 participate in the Employees' Retirement System of Alabama may
- 15 participate in the Employees' Retirement System of Alabama
- 16 upon the same terms and conditions as may be specified by law
- for any other employee in the same retirement system. A mayor
- 18 holding office at the time of the ratification of this
- 19 amendment shall be eligible to purchase service credit in the
- 20 Employees' Retirement System for the time the official has
- 21 served in the current office. No individual may participate in
- 22 both a supernumerary program and the Employees' Retirement
- 23 System based on the same service.
- Upon ratification of this constitutional amendment, the
- 25 Code Commissioner shall number and place this amendment as
- 26 appropriate in the constitution omitting this instructional
- 27 paragraph and may make the following nonsubstantive revisions:
- 28 change capitalization, spelling, and punctuation for purposes





- 29 of style and uniformity; correct manifest grammatical,
- 30 clerical, and typographical errors; and correct incorrect
- 31 cross-references.
- 32 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment
- 33 shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 284.01 of
- 34 the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, and the election laws of
- 35 this state.
- 36 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall
- 37 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional
- 38 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the
- 39 following description of the substance or subject matter of
- 40 the proposed constitutional amendment:
- "Relating to Geneva County, proposing an amendment to
- 42 the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, to allow mayors to
- 43 participate in the Employees' Retirement System of Alabama
- 44 under certain conditions.
- 45 Proposed by Act ."
- This description shall be followed by the following
- 47 language:
