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PROPOSED AMENDMENT

In Jackson County, the mayors of municipalities in the

17 county may participate in the Employees' Retirement System of

18 Alabama under the same terms and conditions as other employees

in the same retirement system. Any mayor holding office at the

20 time of the ratification of this amendment shall be eligible

to purchase service credit in the Employees' Retirement System

for the time the official has served in the current office. No

person may participate in both a supernumerary program and the

Employees' Retirement System based on the same service.

Upon ratification of this constitutional amendment, the

26 Code Commissioner shall number and place this amendment as

27 appropriate in the constitution omitting this instructional

28 paragraph and may make the following nonsubstantive revisions:

- 29 change capitalization, hierarchy, spelling, and punctuation
- 30 for purposes of style and uniformity; correct manifest

- 32 internal or external citations and cross-references; and
- 33 translate effective dates.
- 34 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment
- 35 shall be held in accordance with Sections 284, 284.01, and 285
- of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, and the election laws
- 37 of this state.
- 38 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall
- 39 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional
