- An ERS service retiree employed with an ERS or TRS member agency may continue to receive retirement benefits provided the retired member meets both of the following conditions:
 - The retiree must not be employed or under contract for permanent, full-time employment.
 - The retiree's compensation cannot exceed the limitation on earnings. The limits are subject to change each year based upon the Consumer Price Index (CPI). The limit for the 2017 calendar year is \$30,000. The limit for the 2018 calendar year will be \$31,000. More information on postretirement employment can be found here.
