4	SYNOPSIS:
5	This bill would provide for a benefit increase
6	for certain retirees of the Employees' Retirement
7	System on October 1, 2024.

10	A BILL
11	TO BE ENTITLED
12	AN ACT

14	Providing for a benefit increase for certain retirees
15	and beneficiaries of the Employees' Retirement System
16	effective October 1, 2024.
17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
18	Section 1. (a) Commencing October 1, 2024, and subject
19	to the provisions of HB201 of the 2024 Regular Session, each
20	individual, except those whose employer participated in the
21	Employees' Retirement System pursuant to Sections 36-27-6,
22	36-27-7, and 36-27-7.1, Code of Alabama 1975, whose effective
23	date of retirement for purposes of receiving benefits from the
24	Employees' Retirement System is prior to October 1, 2023, and
25	who is receiving or is entitled to receive a monthly allowance
26	from the Employees' Retirement System, shall receive a
27	cost-of-living increase of three percent in their gross
28	monthly benefit, but not less than fifteen dollars (\$15) per



29 month.

30 (b) Beneficiaries of deceased members or deceased 31 retirees, except where the deceased member or deceased retiree 32 retired from an employer participating in the Employees' 33 Retirement System pursuant to Sections 36-27-6, 36-27-7, and 36-27-7.1, Code of Alabama 1975, provided the date of death 34 for the deceased member, or the effective date of retirement 35 36 for the deceased retiree for purposes of receiving benefits 37 from the Employees' Retirement System was prior to October 1, 2023, shall receive the cost-of-living increase in the amount 38 39 attained by the retiree. In no case shall the cost-of-living increase be less than fifteen dollars (\$15) per month. 40

(c) Any future survivor allowance shall be adjusted as provided in the member's original option selection for those eligible retirees who have selected a monthly survivor allowance payable to a designated beneficiary upon the death of the retiree, or as otherwise provided by law in the case of a qualifying member who dies prior to October 1, 2024.

47 (d) The Board of Control of the Employees' Retirement 48 System shall determine annually the amount required to pay the 49 cost of the increased allowance provided under this section 50 and shall notify the chief fiscal officer of each employer of 51 the per centum rates of earnable compensation of the members 52 required to be paid to the retirement systems. Each employer 53 of members of the Employees' Retirement System shall pay on account of the increases provided in this section in the same 54 manner and from the same source of funds as provided in 55 56 Section 36-27-24, Code of Alabama 1975, it being the intent of



57 the Legislature that the cost of providing the increases in 58 this section shall be distributed from all funds in proportion 59 to the salaries paid therefrom for active members.

60 (e) Pursuant to HB201 of the 2024 Regular Session, the Employees' Retirement System shall pay the benefit increase to 61 62 the eligible retirees and beneficiaries provided for in this 63 section only if the annual cost of the increase as estimated 64 by the actuary of the system is included and appropriated in 65 the State General Fund appropriation act for each fiscal year by a separate employer rate. In any fiscal year in which the 66 67 required separate employer rate is not identified and appropriated in the appropriation act, eligible retirees and 68 69 beneficiaries shall not receive, and the Employees' Retirement 70 System shall not be required to pay, the increase in that 71 fiscal year. The benefit increase may be resumed in any subsequent fiscal year if included in that year's 72 73 appropriation act.

74 Section 2. (a) Commencing October 1, 2024, each 75 individual whose employer participated in the Employees' 76 Retirement System pursuant to Sections 36-27-6, 36-27-7, and 77 36-27-7.1, Code of Alabama 1975, whose effective date of 78 retirement for purposes of receiving benefits from the 79 Employees' Retirement System is prior to October 1, 2023, and 80 who is receiving or is entitled to receive a monthly allowance 81 from the Employees' Retirement System, may receive a cost-of-living increase of three percent in their gross 82 monthly benefit, but not less than fifteen dollars (\$15) per 83 84 month, if the employer elects to come under this section. Any



employer making the election to come under this section shall 85 86 bear the cost of the cost-of-living increases paid to its 87 employees pursuant to this section. Any employer participating 88 under Section 36-27-6, 36-27-7, and 36-27-7.1, Code of Alabama 89 1975, may elect to come under this section at any time and 90 have this section become effective on October 1, 2024, or on 91 October 1 of any subsequent fiscal year, and the employer 92 shall not be required to pay this cost-of-living increase 93 retroactively unless the employer elects to fund the increase.

(b) If the employer elects to come under this section,
beneficiaries of deceased members or deceased retirees retired
from an employer participating in the Employees' Retirement
System pursuant to Section 36-27-6, 36-27-7, and 36-27-7.1,
Code of Alabama 1975, shall receive the same cost-of-living
increase provided in Section 1, but not less than fifteen
dollars (\$15) per month.

(c) Any future survivor allowance shall be adjusted as provided in the member's original option selection for those eligible retirees who have selected a monthly survivor allowance payable to a designated beneficiary upon the death of the retiree, or as otherwise provided by law in the case of a qualifying member who dies prior to October 1, 2024.

(d) If the employer elects to come under this section, the Board of Control of the Employees' Retirement System shall determine annually the amount required to pay the cost of the increased allowance provided under this section and shall notify the chief fiscal officer of each employer of the per centum rates of earnable compensation of the members required



113 to be paid to the retirement systems. Each employer of members of the Employees' Retirement System shall pay on account of 114 115 the increases provided in this section in the same manner and 116 from the same source of funds as provided in Section 36-27-6 and 36-27-7, Code of Alabama 1975, it being the intent of the 117 118 Legislature that the cost of providing the increases in this 119 section shall be distributed from all funds in proportion to 120 the salaries paid therefrom for active members.

(e) Commencing October 1, 2024, any retired employee 121 who retired from a city, town, county, or public or 122 123 quasi-public organization of the state before the city, town, 124 county, or public or quasi-public organization of the state 125 became a member of the Employees' Retirement System, and who 126 is receiving a monthly benefit prior to October 1, 2024, 127 administered by the Employees' Retirement System, and whose years of creditable service have not been made known to the 128 129 Employees' Retirement System, may receive an increase in 130 benefits of three percent, except that no pensioner shall 131 receive an increase of less than fifteen dollars (\$15) per 132 month, provided the retired employee retired prior to October 133 1, 2023, and the employer elects to come under this section.

(f) Commencing October 1, 2024, beneficiaries of Employees' Retirement System pensioners described in subsection (a) shall receive an increase of three percent of their gross monthly benefit, but not less than fifteen dollars (\$15) per month, provided the date of death for the deceased pensioner, or the effective date of retirement for the deceased pensioner was prior to October 1, 2023, and the local



141 units elect to fund the increase.

142 (g) Commencing October 1, 2024, any pensioner or 143 annuitant who retired prior to October 1, 2023, from a city, 144 town, county, or public or quasi-public organization of the 145 state before the city, town, county, or public or quasi-public 146 organization of the state became a member of the Employees' 147 Retirement System and is receiving a monthly benefit not 148 administered by the Employees' Retirement System shall receive an increase of three percent of their gross monthly benefit, 149 but not less than fifteen dollars (\$15) per month, provided 150 151 the city, town, county, or public or quasi-public organization of the state elects to fund the increase. 152

153 Section 3. Any individual who received benefits under 154 the Medicaid Program and whose eligibility for Medicaid 155 benefits would be impaired by the cost-of-living increase provided by this act shall not be entitled to receive the 156 157 aforementioned increase. Any individual who subsequently 158 applies for benefits under the Medicaid Program and that 159 individual's eligibility to receive benefits is impaired by 160 the cost-of-living increase provided by this act, shall not be 161 entitled to receive the increase subsequent to the date that 162 the member files application for benefits under the Medicaid 163 Program.

Section 4. This act shall become effective on October 165 1, 2024.
