## HB90 Enrolled

1 Enrolled, An Act,

2 To propose an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama  
3 of 2022, relating to St. Clair County; to allow mayors of  
4 municipalities in the county to participate in the Employees'  
5 Retirement System of Alabama under certain conditions.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

7 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution  
8 of Alabama of 2022, is proposed:

### 9 PROPOSED AMENDMENT

10 In St. Clair County, the mayor of a municipality that  
11 participates in the Employees' Retirement System of Alabama  
12 may participate in the retirement system upon the same terms  
13 and conditions as may be specified by law for any other  
14 employee in the same retirement system. A mayor holding office  
15 at the time of ratification of this amendment shall be  
16 eligible to purchase service credit in the Employees'  
17 Retirement System of Alabama for the time the official has  
18 served in that office. No person may participate in both a  
19 supernumerary program and the Employees' Retirement System of  
20 Alabama based on the same service.

21 Upon ratification of this constitutional amendment, the  
22 Code Commissioner shall number and place this amendment as  
23 appropriate in the constitution omitting this instructional  
24 paragraph and may make the following nonsubstantive revisions:  
25 change capitalization, hierarchy, spelling, and punctuation  
26 for purposes of style and uniformity; correct manifest  
27 grammatical, clerical, and typographical errors; revise

internal or external citations and cross-references; harmonize language; and translate effective dates.

END PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held in accordance with Sections 284, 284.01, and 285 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, and the election laws of this state. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the following description of the substance or subject matter of the proposed constitutional amendment:

"Relating to St. Clair County, proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, to allow mayors to participate in the Employees' Retirement System of Alabama under certain conditions.

Proposed by Act \_\_\_\_."

This description shall be followed by the following language:

"Yes( ) No( )."

Section 3. The proposed amendment shall become valid as part of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, when approved by a majority of the qualified electors voting thereon.
