RSA has learned that some RSA members have been contacted by telephone and asked to provide personal information with the promise of an additional bonus or some other benefit. THIS IS A SCAM. RSA, PEEHIP, and their Board members will NEVER call, text, or email you and ask for your Social Security number, PID, birthday, checking account information, or credit card numbers.

It is important in this day and age to protect your personal information. Many of these scam callers are targeting our members based upon their social media posts and information. Beware of the information that you share on social media. A scam caller may appear to know you based on your social media profile or posts and then use that information to lure you into providing more identifying information. It is best to limit sharing of personal information in a public forum.
