5	Under existing law, certain employees of the
6	Alabama High School Athletic Association may
7	participate in the Teachers' Retirement System of
8	Alabama and the Public Education Employees' Health
9	Insurance Plan by virtue of their employment with the
10	association.
11	This bill would prohibit participation by future
12	employees hired by the Alabama High School Athletic
13	Association.
14	This bill would also prohibit public K-12
15	schools from membership in an athletic association
16	under certain circumstances.

Section 16-25-7, Code of Alabama 1975, is 33 amended to read as follows: "\$16-25-7 34 35 (a) All persons now Except as provided in subsection 36 (c), all individuals employed on a full-time basis in an administrative or clerical capacity by the Alabama High School 37 Athletic Association may become members of the Teachers' 38 39 Retirement System of Alabama within 90 days after October 1, 1967, subject to such the rules and regulations as may be 40 promulgated adopted by the Board of Control of the Teachers' 41 42 Retirement System of Alabama. Any person hereafter Except as 43 provided by subsection (c), all individuals employed in an administrative or clerical capacity by the Alabama High School 44 Athletic Association shall be deemed to be a "teacher" as 45 46 defined in Section 16-25-1 and shall be entitled to the 47 benefits thereof. Notwithstanding the provisions of this 48 section and other sections of the Teachers' Retirement System 49 law, it is provided that the Alabama High School Athletic 50 Association shall pay to the retirement system the employer 51 cost for coverage of its employees, such cost to which shall 52 be determined by an actuary employed by the Board of Control 53 and under rules and regulations established by said the Board 54 of Control board. 55 (b) Any person now Except as provided in subsection 56 (c), any individual employed as set out in subsection (a) of

57	this section shall be entitled to may receive credit for all
58	service as a "teacher" or as an employee of the Alabama High
59	School Athletic Association rendered by him or her prior to
60	October 1, 1967; provided, that a sum equal to the total
61	contributions which he or she would have made as a member
62	during the period of such employment plus regular interest at
63	four percent is paid within 90 days after October 1, 1967.

67	athletic association, may participate in the Teacher's

75	Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first
76	day of the third month following its passage and approval by
77	the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
