OVERVIEW:

The Software Developer unclassified position works in the Information Technology Services (ITS) Division of the Retirement Systems of Alabama. The RSA is embarking on a multi-year modernization project and will be implementing FileNet as the enterprise content manager for the organization. This position will require extensive knowledge of the FileNet application and the administrator skillset that is necessary to install and configure FileNet from the ground up. The Software Developer will work closely with the modernization project team and vendors to properly configure FileNet to replace an existing imaging application, convert existing images from that existing imaging application into FileNet and ensure that FileNet will work with existing legacy applications as well as the new pension administration application that is being implemented.

REQUIREMENTS:

Performance Abilities / Minimum Qualifications:

- Expertise in Enterprise Content Management and experience in Systems Integration and solution architecture using IBM FileNet P8 platform.
- Have proficient and technical knowledge in imaging / capture and document storage.
- Have hands-on experience in business process management workflows and Business Process
 Modeling Notation (BPMN) and integration with custom applications using component manager.
- Experience in using various FileNet Administration tools to manage content and active work items and also an understanding of custom and out of the box case analyzer reports.
- Understanding of FileNet configuration manager and deployment of various FileNet components in respective layers in a load balanced environment.
- Have knowledge, understanding and experience in Software Development Life Cycle (SDLC) methodologies and project management processes.
- Experience in implementing an Enterprise Content Management (ECM) solution using IBM FileNet P8 suite and integrating through Web Services and other application programming interfaces (API).
- Able to understand the technical specifications and requirements and effectively translate them to business users and provide training and operational support.
- Ability to manage customer communications and provide the necessary information to business users.
- Ensure the reliability and secure operation of the pre-production and production server environment.
