MR. WHALEY: Okay. We will go ahead, if we can, and start our TRS Election Committee meeting.

MS. KIRK: Eric is here.
MR. WHALEY: Okay. Dr. Mackey is here.

MR. MACKEY: I'm here.
MR. WHALEY: We have three members of the Board total: That's Kelly Butler, Dr. Mackey, and myself. And we do have two of the members present. Dr. Mackey and I are present. So, we are able to conduct business.

And so, at this time, I would like to call this meeting to order and ask for an approval of the minutes of the September 15, 2020, meeting.

MR. MACKEY: I so -- I move we approve the minutes.

MR. WHALEY: Okay. Thank you, Dr. Mackey. And I will second that. All in favor say "aye."

MR. WHALEY: Any opposed, like sign?
(No response.)
MR. WHALEY: So, that would -- the motion would pass.

Okay. At this time, we need to certify the election results that Mr. Yancey talked about at the end of our last meeting. So, I would like to call upon Deborah Barrett -- I mean, Deborah -Deborah Barrett was only my mind but she is retired -- Deborah Kirk to lead us through this portion.

MS. KIRK: Okay. In front of you, you should have the election results. Now, just a recap, at the beginning of this election, we did have an issue with ballots. It was a coding issue.

MR. WHALEY: Deborah, do I have that?

MS. KIRK: Yeah.
MR. WHALEY: Is that it?

MS. KIRK: Yes.
MR. WHALEY: Okay. Thank you.
MS. KIRK: Okay. So, just a recap on the coding error just so it's -everyone is kind of up to date on that.

There were ballots that were mailed to superintendents, and they received the support personnel ballot which they should not have done. They were all contacted. Those ballots were excluded by the election company, and they did not count.

Then there was another issue where a few teachers, a little over 1,200, received the support personnel ballots instead, and so those were excluded. The teachers were contacted and new ballots were sent immediately. And all the candidates were notified of this issue.

We are going to work -- As soon as this election is certified, we are going to work with ITS and make sure this coding issue doesn't happen again. We are putting
in place some double-checks on the files.
So, we don't anticipate this happening again, but $I$ just wanted to make sure that everyone was clear on that.

For the results, we did have four different positions. The first one for Higher Education Number 2, we had Kelli Shomaker, the incumbent, and her opponent Jeremy Reed. Kelli did win that by a landslide. She had 2,393 votes to 634 . So, she will be reelected. There was 9.46\% turnout in that election.

For the second position, it was Principal; that was Jeff Cole, the incumbent. And his opponents were Thomas Jones and Anthony Jason Davidson. There will be a runoff because no one receive the majority of votes. But the runoff will be between Jeff Cole and Thomas Jones.

Now, those ballots will go out in January and be due back in February, and then we will meet to certify those. That was a 7.14\% turnout for principal.

For Support Personnel Number 2, that was Russell Twilley, the incumbent, versus Amy Knight Fowler. Ms. Fowler won with 1,199 votes to 782. And that was 5.18\% turnout.

And the last one was Teacher Number 3. That was Charlene McCoy's position and versus Mary Beth Tate. Mary Beth Tate did win with 1,005 votes to 926. The total turnout for that was $4.38 \%$.

MR. WHALEY: Okay. All right. So, we have this report available to us with the winners and then one runoff.

MS. KIRK: Correct.
MR. WHALEY: Okay. So, we need a motion to certify the election results as given by Ms. Kirk.

MR. MACKEY: I make the motion we certify the election results as read out.

MR. WHALEY: I second that. And we vote for that. All in favor say "aye." (Committee members saying "aye").

MR. WHALEY: Very good.
MS. KIRK: I have signature sheets for y'all to sign.

MR. WHALEY: Okay.
MS. KIRK: And I can get that over to Dr. Mackey, as well.

MR. WHALEY: Okay. Is there anything else that you have today?

MR. MACKEY: Tuesday -- Well, if you need it before Tuesday, they are actually running stuff back and forth. I am getting a daily mail delivery to the house.

MS. KIRK: Okay.
MR. MACKEY: So, if you need it before then, I can get it over here.

MS. KIRK: Okay. I'll just contact Leeanne then.

MR. WHALEY: Do you have anything else?

MS. KIRK: No. That was it.
MR. WHALEY: Okay. All right.
Motion to adjourn?
