So, we don't anticipate this happening again, but I just wanted to make sure that everyone was clear on that.

For the results, we did have four different positions. The first one for Higher Education Number 2, we had Kelli Shomaker, the incumbent, and her opponent Jeremy Reed. Kelli did win that by a landslide. She had 2,393 votes to 634. So, she will be reelected. There was 9.46% turnout in that election.

For the second position, it was
Principal; that was Jeff Cole, the
incumbent. And his opponents were Thomas
Jones and Anthony Jason Davidson. There
will be a runoff because no one receive the
majority of votes. But the runoff will be
between Jeff Cole and Thomas Jones.

Now, those ballots will go out in January and be due back in February, and then we will meet to certify those. That was a 7.14% turnout for principal.
