### TRS Board Election Results and Runoff Election

- ◆ The TRS Election Committee met Tuesday, November 26, to certify the regular election results. A runoff election will be held for the Retired Position, No. 2, between Joe Ward and Anita Gibson.
  - ◇ Ballots for this election will be mailed no later than January 6, and must be returned to Election-America in New York, by 4:00 p.m., February 17.
  - ◇ To be eligible to vote for the Retired No. 2 Position, you must be a former active member of the TRS and currently on the TRS retired payroll.
