Week 3 Update

The Legislature convened for the seventh, eighth, and ninth legislative days of the Regular Session this week.

The House amended and passed HB71 by Rep. Clouse. As amended, the bill would allow emergency medical services personnel to receive hazardous duty credit. This bill now moves to the Senate for consideration.

The Legislature introduced two new bills dealing with RSA:

- HB201, by Rep. Clouse, would establish a procedure for granting and funding TRS and ERS retiree benefit increases.
- SB151, by Sen. Orr, would prohibit the ERS and TRS boards from sacrificing investment returns or taking additional risks to promote ESG agendas.
